To all students attending the Lab Course Modern Physic I and II

Dear students

Due to repeatedly occurred larcenies out of the lab course rooms as well as from other rooms in the building of exact sciences (ExWi), we were forced to provide the doors with specific cylinders and snap locks. Therefore, the access to these rooms are only granted with an appropriate key or the institute key of the assistants.

All students enrolled in the lab course can obtain a corresponding key with Franz Marbacher, room 903 (1st floor). According to the cantonal rules, there are certain formalities, which have to be adhered to:

1. At the reception of the key you shall sign a debt acknowledgement, stating that you are aware of the fact, that you owe the University of Bern a lump-sum fee of CHF 200 in case of a key loss.
2. Mandatory requirement for the attestations for the lab course is the return of the lab door key to Franz Marbacher. He will state the return on the debt acknowledgement and hand it back to you.
3. The attestations for the lab course will only be issued after proof of returning the lab key.

We very much regret to have to introduce this rule due to these unpleasant and recurring incidents, which also generate extensive extra work to us. With this regulation, access to the rooms of the lab course is granted during the opening hours of the building.
